Participants are expected to be from departments of different nuclear facilities, regulatory board, Security personnel and organizations involved in nuclear material or radioactive material related activities.</p> <p>Nominations are also invited from agencies involved in security of nuclear and other important installations, educational / research/ training institutions involved in Security in general and Nuclear Security in particular.</p> <p>Participants will be selected depending upon the availability of seats and will be at discretion of competent authority.</p>
Objectives	The objective of this workshop is to familiarize participants with the importance of security culture for the organisations involving nuclear or radioactive material. Participants will be made familiar with concept of nuclear security culture, roles and responsibilities of personnel involved in organisation at different stages and assessment of nuclear security culture. Inter relationship of safety and security culture in nuclear installations will also be explored.
Nature of the Workshop	The workshop will feature a series of lectures, discussions, case studies and work group exercises. Workgroup exercises will be conducted after relevant lecture for better understanding of the topics. Participants will be introduced to hypothetical nuclear facility and will be discussing in group about the enhancement of nuclear security culture.
